To be eligible for voting member status, institutions must be accredited by an agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or a similar agency accrediting independent schools or similar agency outside the US. Institutions must also be entitled to exemption from US federal income tax under Section 115(a) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as a public educational institution, or under Sections 501(c)(3) and 509(c)(1), (2) or (3) of this code or subsequent statutes. Nonprofit educational institutions in other countries which meet the above standards, whether or not those institutions have actually requested or received a determination of that status from the IRS are also eligible for membership. Organizations that do not meet these criteria may still affiliate with CASE as members with non-voting status.
