My priorities shifted. I needed to be with my mom and support my family. My plans for college and a bright future started fading away. My mother was only 48 when she died. I miss her every day.



I am nearing the finish line.
























We believe every person who is determined to change his or her life through the pursuit of higher education should be afforded that opportunity.




We want everyone to have the opportunity to receive an education. To do something big with their lives. To be given a chance at a career. A sustainable way of life. A decent standard of living.
