I dream of becoming a robotics engineer, bringing breakthroughs and helping the global community solve the most pressing problems it faces.





At 36 years old, I am now pursuing a new career in engineering, with an eye toward aerospace engineering systems and the goal of obtaining a master's degree. This spring I started an internship at Northrop Grumman through a connection made from Educational Foundation Board Member, Mark W. Cleary.


As a first generation college student, I plan to major in international business.


