A conversation with Professor Ann Burgess and John Douglas

In the late 1970s, Boston College Professor of Nursing Ann Burgess, a pioneer in assessing and treating trauma victims, and then-FBI special investigator John Douglas helped develop a new type of criminal profiling to better understand notorious serial killers. Their experiences were captured in *Mindhunter*, a 1995 book that became the basis for the fictionalized Netflix hit series. 



With Allen Burgess, the three wrote the *Crime Classification Manual: A Standard System for* Investigations of *Classification*
