Anatomy Lab — Cadaver Anatomy Review for Physical Therapy

Jackson Hall – 5th Floor

Cost: \$100 (Reunion Kick Off event at the Weisman Art Museum, following the lab, is included in cost)

The perfect way to start out the reunion weekend is by coming back to campus for learning! Join us to refresh your knowledge on how muscles, nerves, ligaments, arteries, etc. are arranged in the body and how these structures can be injured and rehabilitated. **Upon completion, each participant will receive a certificate of 4 contact hours/Category 1.**

Course Description

This course will use recently dissected cadavers to show the real anatomy of the muscles, nerves, arteries and joints of the upper and lower extremities. The group will be split into four subgroups and rotate between four different anatomical dissections of the UE and LE. Gloves and aprons will be provided.

Course Objectives

- 1) Observe the arrangement of muscles, nerves, vessels and joints of the extremities.
- 2) Discuss common clinical conditions and treatment approaches based on the observed anatomy.

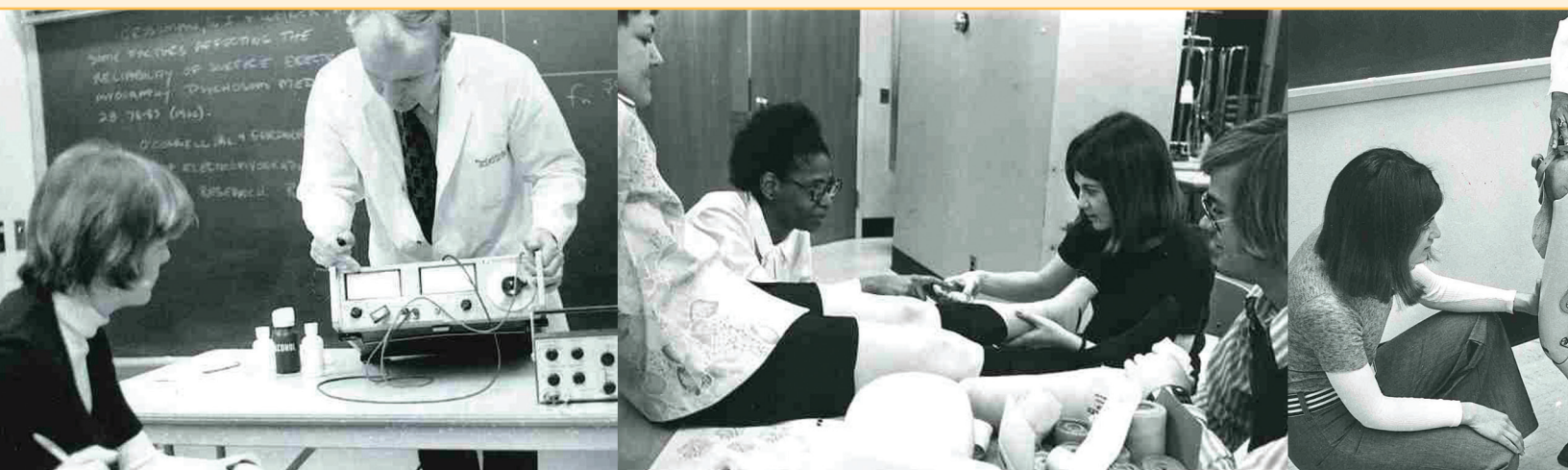

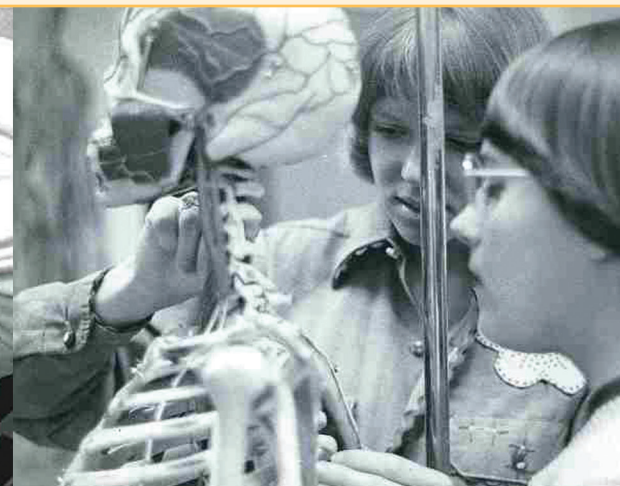
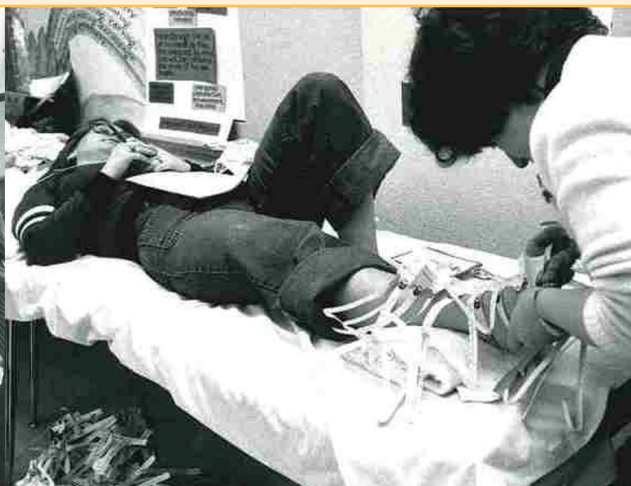
Campus Tours

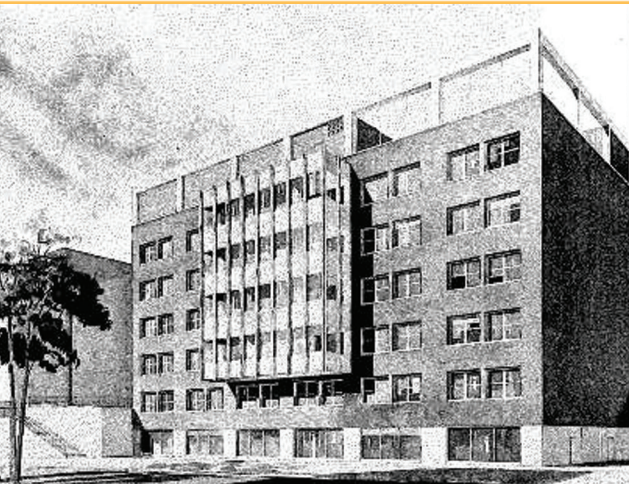

Ted Anderson graduated from Santa Clara University with a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry and an emphasis in Organic and BioChemistry. He then graduated from Marquette University in 2006 with a Doctorate in Physical Therapy, where Dean Larry “The Man” Pan noted “on any given day we were not sure if Ted would fail out or be President of the APTA.”



Ted moved to Maui in 2008 and soon after began Venture Physical Therapy with his wife Ann Anderson. He has since expanded the practice to two clinics and In-Home Therapy covering Maui and Lana'i.
