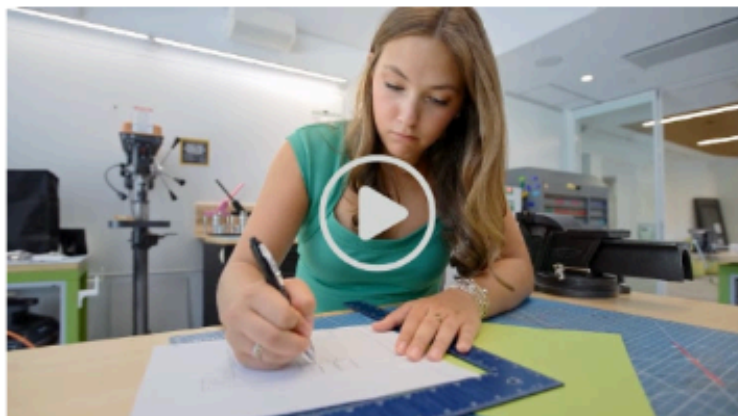

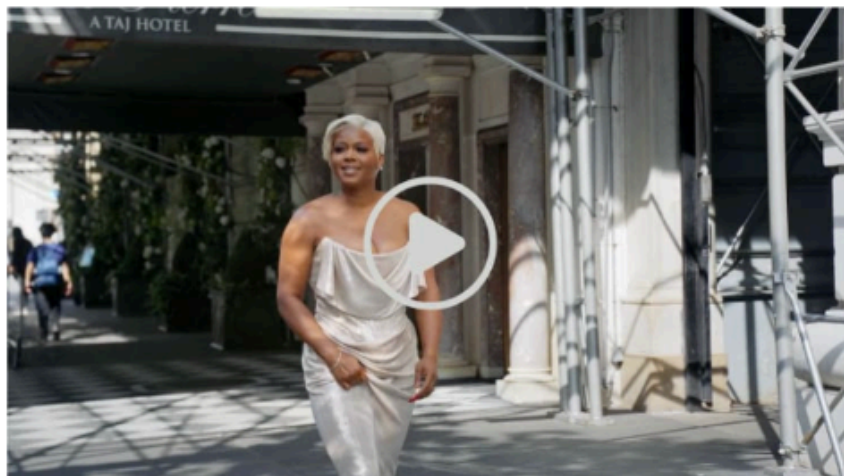

ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT: WILEY BALLARD '12

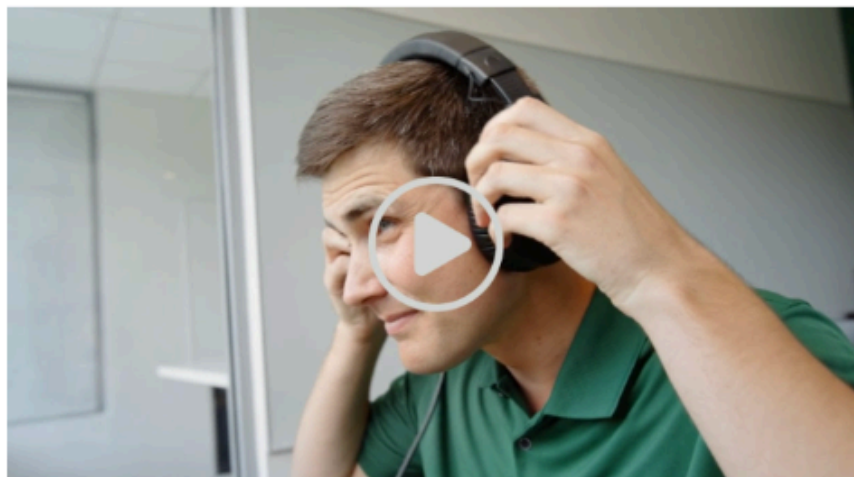

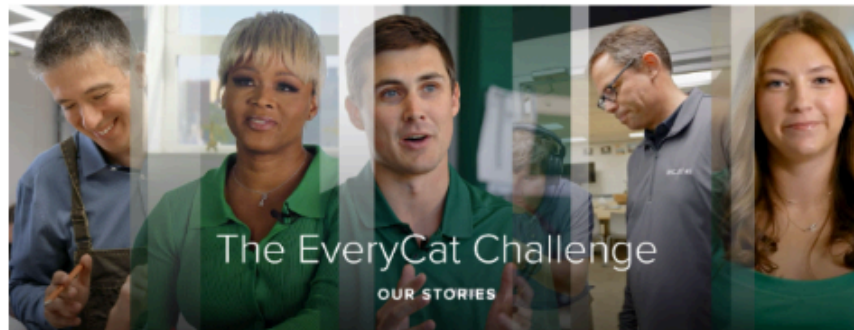

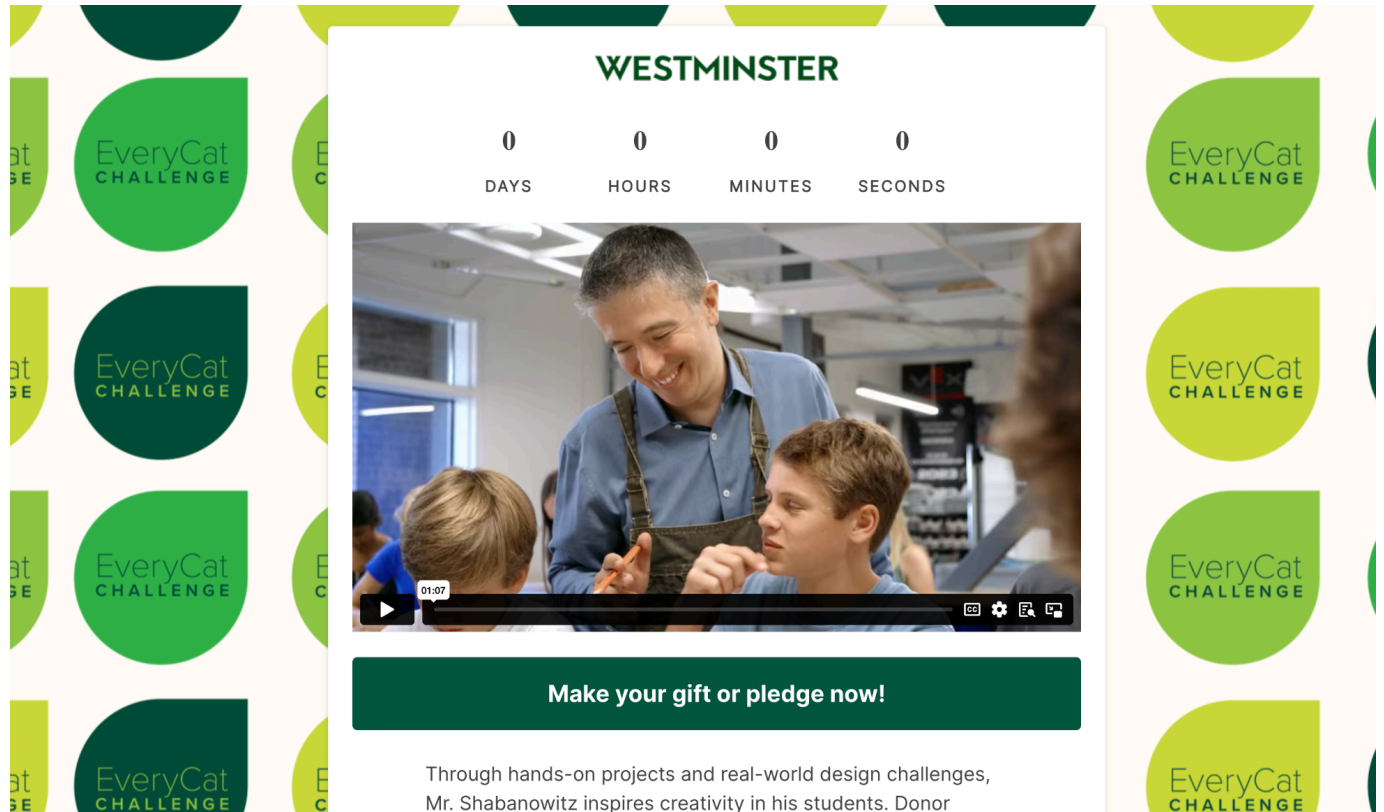
