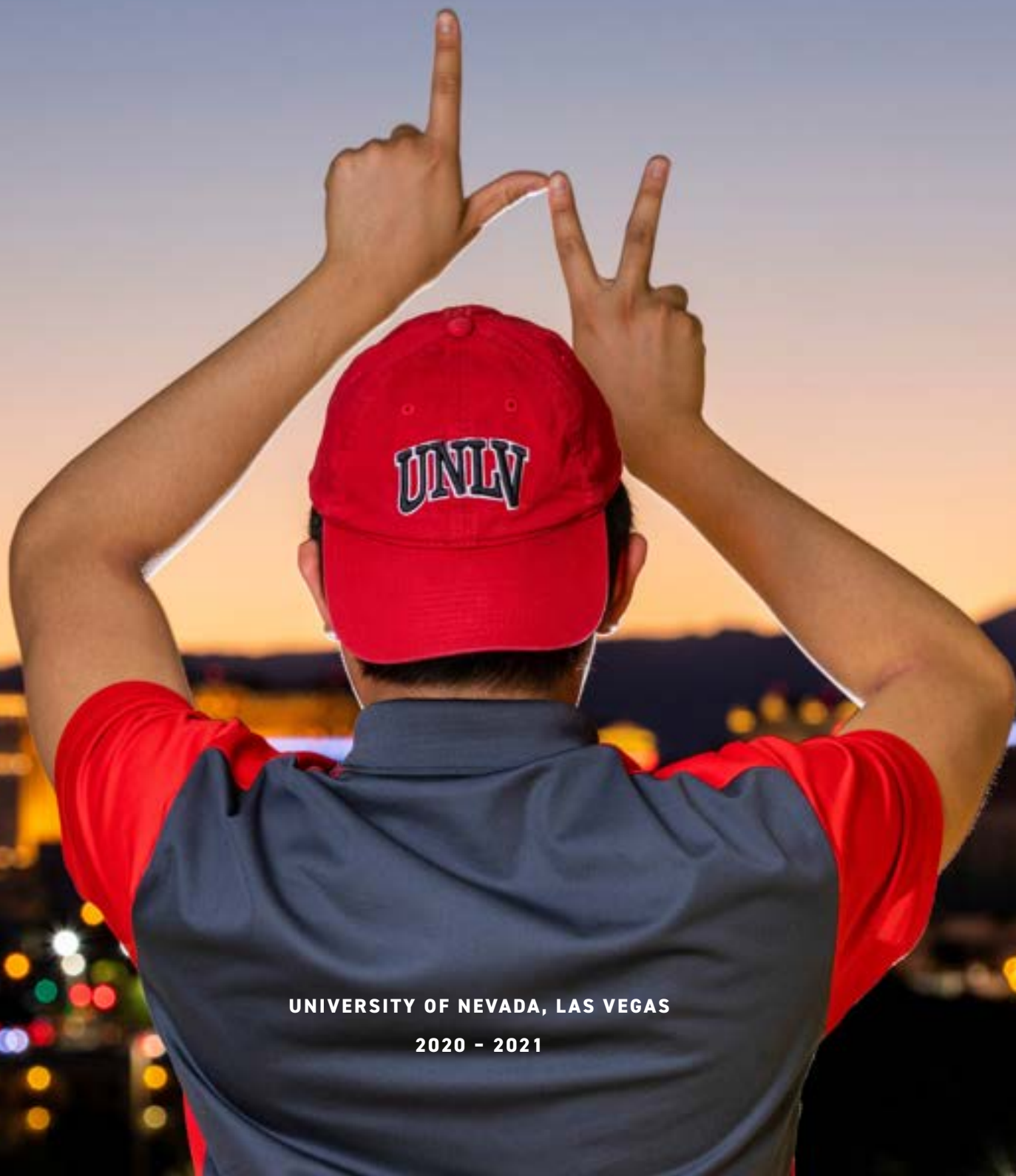

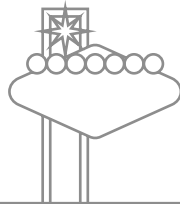

Put it all together and that means UNLV students benefit from nowhere-else opportunities in this 24-hour metropolis.

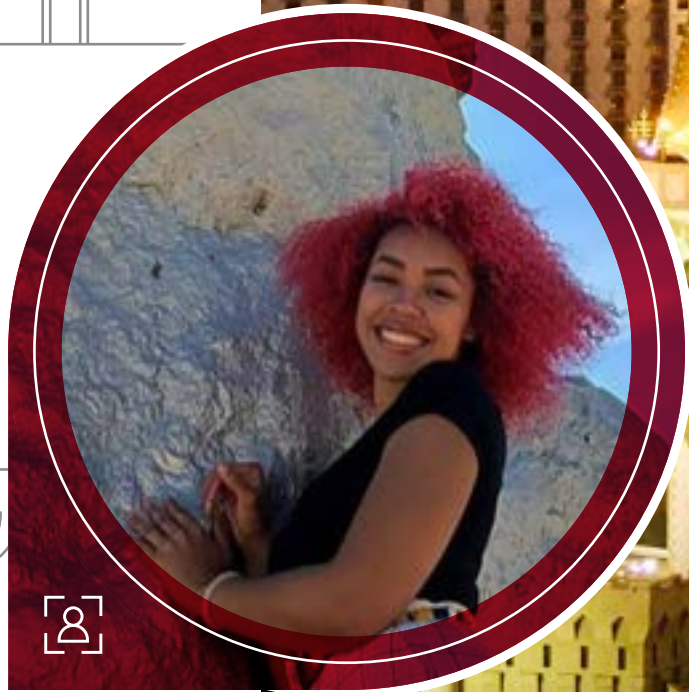

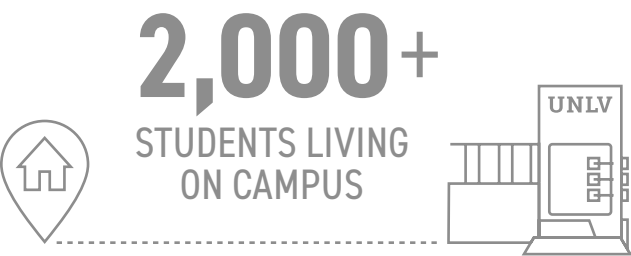


KICK BACK AND RELAX.

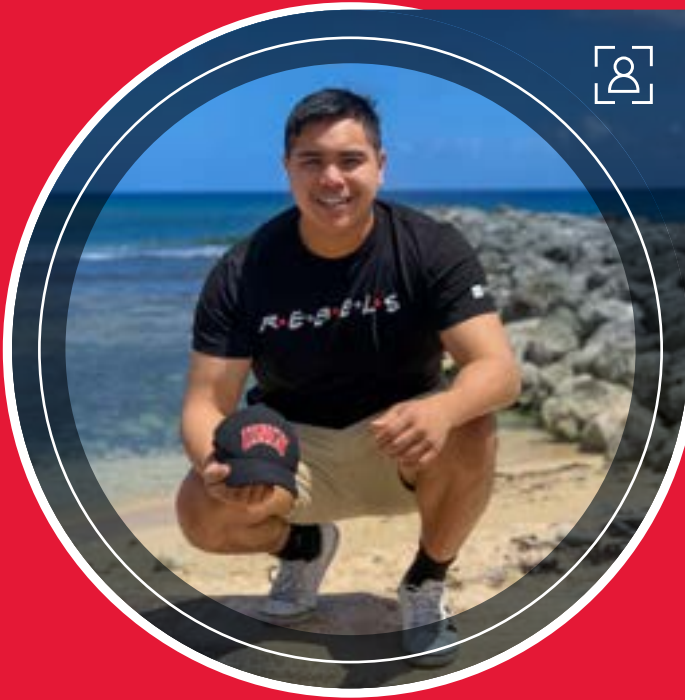

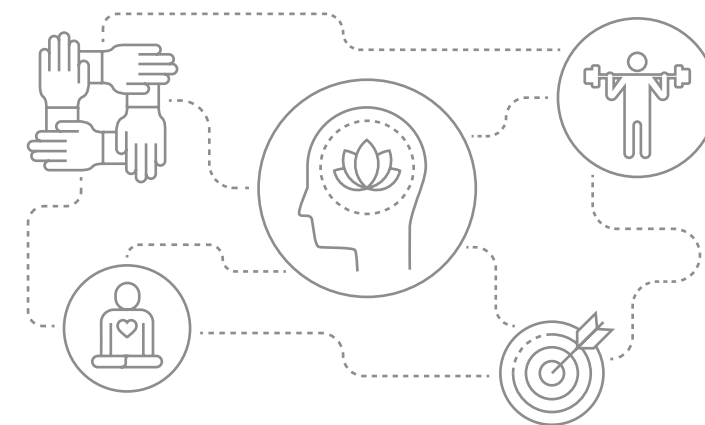


BECOME THE MOST REBEL VERSION OF YOU.

You shouldn't have to struggle to find basic care when you're balancing classes, work, and a social life. UNLV's on-campus clinics will ensure you stay healthy, with easy access to caregivers and a pharmacy, medical labs, dental care, and counseling and psychological services.

Keep it moving at the Student Recreation and Wellness Center with group classes, personal trainers, a six-lane pool, and plenty of courts for a pickup game of basketball or badminton. (Insider tip: The fourth-floor indoor track has stunning views of the city.) Or escape the city altogether through an Outdoor Adventures camping, canoe, or snowshoe trip.

Hungry? Feed your inner foodie at the Student Union, where 10 restaurants are waiting. Pop into the student-run Common Grounds for a quick sandwich. Or for one low price, get your fill of nine daily entrees (vegan options too) and ice cream at our all-you-can-eat Dining Commons.

COLLEGE LIFE WITH A HEFTY DOSE OF VEGAS SIZZLE.

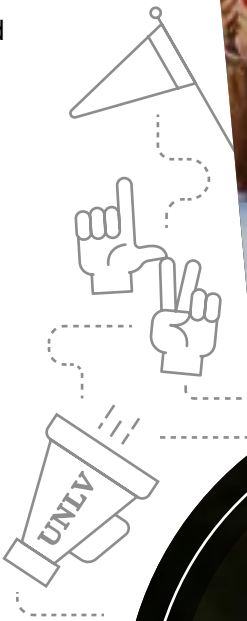
A basketball pregame show with fireworks? Yep, that all started at UNLV.

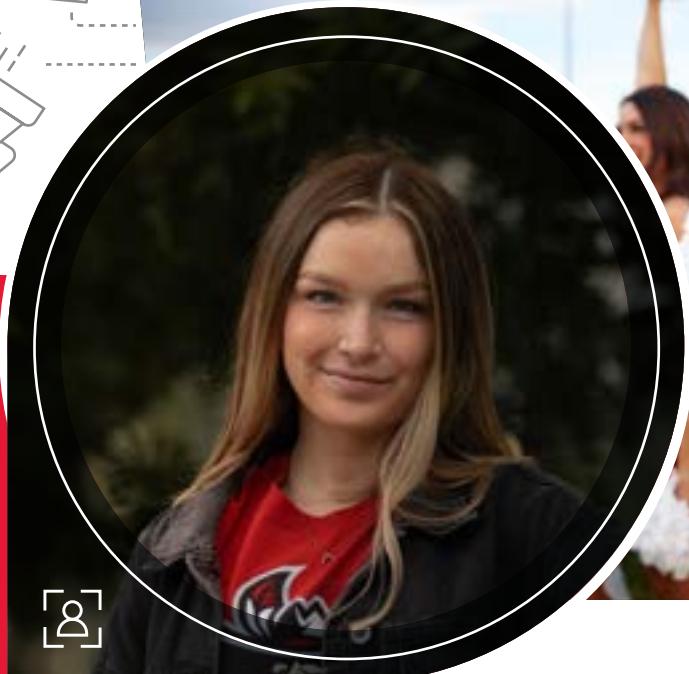


Premier UNLV

UNLV is one of just 130 institutions in the country to receive the Carnegie Commission on Higher Education's "Research 1" designation, the gold standard in academia. That's something only 3 percent of U.S. colleges can claim. And we have the facilities to back it up.

But unlike other R1 universities, you won't have to wait in line behind the grad students before you can get into one of our 45 research centers and institutes.

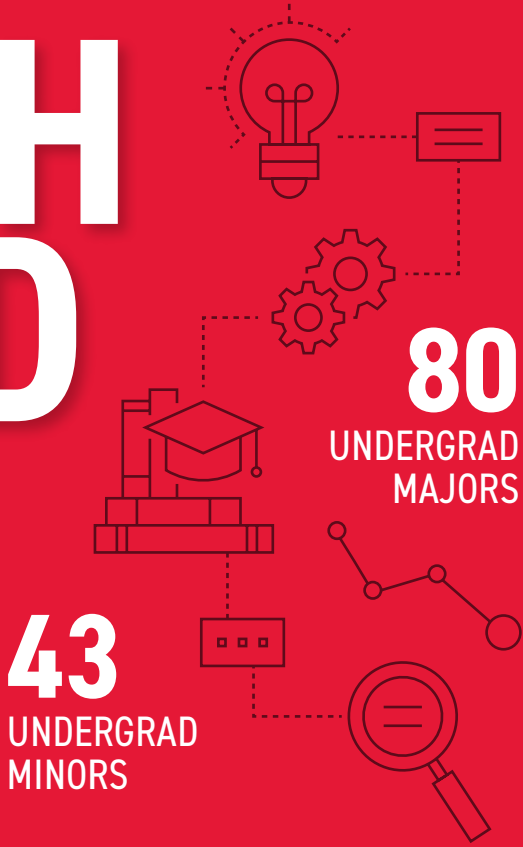

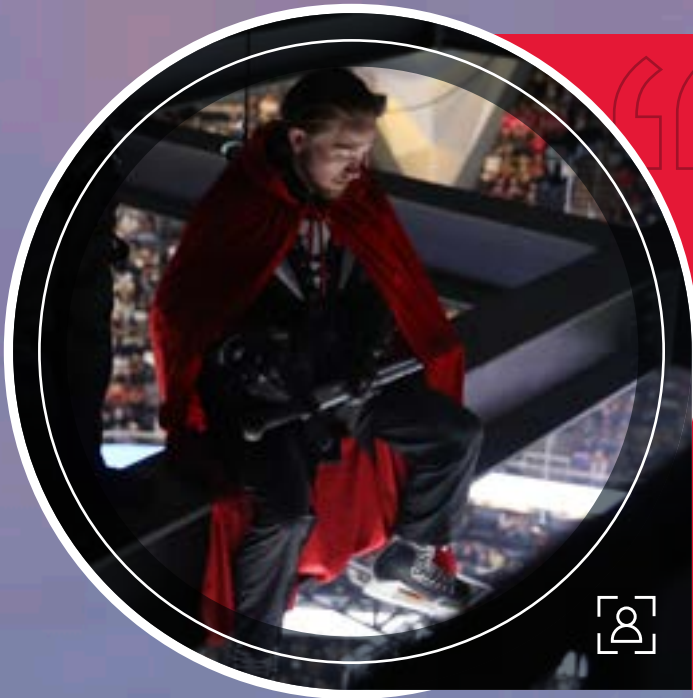

STACKING UP THE AWARDS

UNLV's merit-based and regional scholarships are renewable and stackable. This means you can keep them for all four years here.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE WITHOUT THE FINANCIAL BURDEN

An education shouldn't be a ball-and-chain weighing down your financial health when you're just starting a career. At UNLV, it won't be.

UNLV students graduate with less debt than students from 47 other states, and 76 percent of our students receive some form of financial aid and scholarships. Our regional scholarships can save up to \$2,400 annually for in-state students and \$12,015 annually for out-of-state students. Plus, there's an abundance of need-based aid and merit-based scholarships, too.

Factor in that our graduates land jobs locally, nationally, and internationally, along with the lifetime earning power a degree will bring, and you can see the value of UNLV.

Millennium Scholarship: Up to \$2,400 savings per year
\$8,605 - \$2,400 = \$6,205 annual tuition & fees

The President's Scholarship is stackable with all scholarships listed here except the Merit Scholarships.
