The F&M LGBTQ Alumni Council was officially recognized by the College in January 2015. Its leadership rests in the Board of Directors, a group that is made up of the following positions: President, Marketing & Communications Director, Office of Student and Post-Graduate Development Director, Event Planning Director, Philanthropy Director, Advocacy & Education Director, Student Engagement Director (undergraduate position). As of now, we have filled all positions but the Student Engagement Director.

Since its creation, the Council's primary mission has been:

- To provide LGBTQ alumni/ae and friends of the College with a supportive professional and social network of individuals with similar identities
- To reconnect alumni/ae to the ever-changing F&M campus and the current undergraduate population in order to strengthen support for the College and its students
- To allow the experiences of LGBTQ alumni/ae to serve the intellectual, cultural, and social well-being of students through role modeling and mentoring
- To support the efforts of the Office of Student and Post-Graduate Development by providing formal and informal graduate school and career guidance to current students and graduates
- To identify opportunities to connect and collaborate with faculty and professional staff on LGBTQ-related academic and programming endeavors
- To inform the educational and administrative practices and policies surrounding institutional inclusion and equity as it relates to sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression to build on F&M's commitment to being a diverse and affirming institution

• The F&M LGBTQ Alumni Council has been busy over the past year spreading the word about its creation to interested alumni. A membership database has been created based on records provided to us by the Office of Alumni Relations, as well as through our own personal networks. The majority of our outreach has been through technology (email) and social media (Facebook). We are planning to do some more targeted outreach to specific alumni, as we are hoping that will allow them to feel a personal connection to the Council. We have done similar outreach to students and are hopeful that members of the Board of Directors will be able to attend one of SAGA's upcoming meetings. This will be essential not only in filling our vacant Student Engagement Director position, but also so that we have a better sense of the experiences of current students and how the Council can best support them.

Some of our short term, specific goals include:

- Host an event during Alumni Weekend in June 2017
- Cosponsor/sponsor an event with a Regional Chapter (perhaps DC, Philly, NYC)
- Outreach to alumni about hosting a webinar through OSPGD
- Create an online newsletter to disseminate to membership base
- Attend a SAGA meeting
- Fill the Student Engagement Director position
- October 26 WEBINAR: Hosted by the Office of Student & Post-Graduate Development. Co-Sponsored by the F&M LGBTQ Alumni Council and the Council for Women of F&M.
