### Membership Eligibility

The following shall be eligible for membership as voting members: Non-profit educational institutions from around the world that are accredited by an agency recognised by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or similar agencies outside the United States, non-profit independent schools or non-United States institutions of education that have been appropriately accredited, or non-profit educational organisations closely associated with one or more said entities. To be eligible for voting member status an institution or organisation must also be entitled to exemption from Federal income tax under Section 115(a) or the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law) as a public educational institution, or under Section 501(a) of said code as an organisation described in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 509(a)(1), (2), or (3) of said code. The foregoing shall be deemed to include non-profit educational institutions in non-United States countries which meet the above standards, whether or not those institutions have actually requested or received a determination of that status from the Internal Revenue Service. Non-profit institutions or organisations that do not meet these criteria are may still affiliate with CASE as members with non-voting status. In accordance with CASE bylaws, proprietary educational institutions are not eligible for CASE membership.
